

Anniston Army Depot wins 2007 Excellence in Enterprise Integration Award

Depot Total Asset Visibility System (DTAVS) recognized as Outstanding Government Program

(Alexandria, Virginia, September 20, 2007) Portal Dynamics is proud to announce its deserving client, the Anniston Army Depot's Directorate of Information Management (DOIM), is this year's 'Government' winner of the 2007 Excellence in Enterprise Integration Award. Presented by the Association for Enterprise Integration (AFEI) and selected from more than 85 nominations, the award recognized the outstanding attributes and achievements of Anniston's "Depot Total Asset Visibility System" (DTAVS), a web-based system for tracking the thousands of parts associated with the tanks, armored personnel carriers and other systems as they come into the depot for disassembly, reclamation and ultimately restoration of the equipment.

"This award is well-deserved recognition for the innovative and effective activities undertaken by the DOIM at Anniston under the terrific leadership of Director Alberta Freeman," said Mark Adams, President and CEO of Portal Dynamics. He added, "At Portal Dynamics we are extremely proud to be a part of the Anniston Army Depot DTAVS team, and hope to share the lessons learned from this project with others involved in similar projects."

In 2005 Portal Dynamics began to develop and deploy a materiel management solution, known as the Visual Planner System, a web-based component of the DTAVS, which has served to dramatically improve the line of site "what is where" reclamation activities involved in the disassembly and re-use of parts.

Two years after this effort began the integrated asset tracking system that forms the backbone of DTAVS is now able to give ANAD personnel the ability to identify type, number, and location of reclaimed parts from the point of their induction into the system to their use in the re-manufacturing process. As a result, in the last two years DTAVS has effectively reduced the depot's \$400 million spare parts inventory in half, while reducing re-manufacturing bottlenecks, expediting repair cycles, and saving the U.S. government and taxpayers millions of dollars.
